

They married in Blenheim and had two daughters and a son. Peter was transferred with the Bank to Motueka, Wellington, Masterton, and back to Nelson. They lived in Farnham Drive Richmond and after leaving the Bank built a home in Hill Plough Heights. Peter and Bev did all the landscaping, including collecting the stones and boulders for all the retaining walls. On the hillside that was some achievement. Peter had a lawn mowing business for a few years as an early retirement gig.

Peter loved country music and travelled to many concerts. His Music library is vast and loved playing it on his trusty stereo bought at Spices Home Appliance shop in High Street Motueka. Long time ago.

Peter Loved Classic Cars and drove a Porsche 911 and also a 1968 MG convertible. He travelled all over New Zealand on many Classic Car Tours. His last was with our Z cars and group of four early December last year and was determined to do it whatever his condition. Peter was on the committee of the car club and treasurer for many many years. He was given the Honour of Life Membership Just a few weeks before his passing as recognition for his dedication to the Classic Car Club. He was really chuffed about this.

Peter and Bev joined the Coastal Garden Group and Peter served on the committee for a few years and then became Chairperson. He was always willing to help with the Flower Shows at Mapua. He would help put up the Flower Show signs, and with his trusty Blue Ute would distribute the Garden fertilizer to Members in the Ute or the Honda station wagon was full of plants for the sales table each Club Day. Peter used to say I had plants on my lap all the way to Tasman and sometimes he wondered where in the car he would be able to sit. Garden visits were a must for Peter all around the Nelson area, Blenheim, Hanmer and throughout NZ.

Peter was a very calm Gentleman and was willing to help anyone without being asked. Peter was unwell for 14 months but still carried on as though there was nothing wrong and made it to the Classic Car events whenever possible.

We all have great memories to remember Peter by. We will always be thinking of you Pete forever.



## BOOKING SYSTEMS

Many Restaurants and Cafes are now insisting that bookings are confirmed some days prior to attending their establishment. Further they may well insist that even if you do not attend that the meal is to be paid for.

This has come about due to them having to order and have enough food for the numbers booked and also have enough staff on hand to provide the service.

They will often have to throw out unused food and pay anyway even if people don't show.

On this basis the club, for many functions, may require you to:

1. Confirm your booking/attendance by a given date prior to the event.
2. If required, either pay a deposit or the full amount prior to the date specified.
3. If you decide to cancel after the given date, prior to the event, there will in all probability, be no refund.
4. If you decide after the given date, prior to the event, that you wish to attend then in all probability you will be excluded.
5. If you just show up to attend any function without confirming bookings/attendance then your participation will be at the discretion of the establishment we are attending. Please do not be offended if you are excluded.
6. If the club is subsidising the cost of the event and you do not attend without notifying the club by the given date, prior to the event then you may well be required to refund the club the subsidised amount. This is because the club will be having to pay for your participation in the event even though you do not attend and this results in a direct loss to the club and its members.

When required please ensure your payment is made to the **CORRECT** account specified.




